## FALL/SPRING

## BOYS K - 4th

- Green Short Sleeve Polo, Grey Shorts, brown or black belt, grey or black socks, and ALL black sneakers.
- Green Short Sleeve Polo, Light Grey Pants, brown or black belt, grey or black socks, and ALL black sneakers.


## BOYS 5th - 8th

- Green Short Sleeve Polo, Grey Shorts, brown or black belt, grey or black socks, and ALL black sneakers,
- Green Short Sleeve Polo, Dark Grey Pants, brown or black belt, grey or black socks, and ALL black sneakers.


## GIRLS K - 4th

- Jumper with white Peter Pan short sleeve blouse, green socks, and approved shoes (Sperry Songfish or Brown Leather Eastlands or Mary Janes)
- Short sleeve or Long sleeve green polo with grey shorts with a belt and green socks with approved shoes listed above.


## GIRLS 5th - 8th

- Green Polo Short Sleeve, Plaid Skort, green socks or stockings, and approved shoes (Sperry Songfish or Brown Leather Eastlands)
- Green Polo Short Sleeve, Grey Shorts with belt, green socks, and approved shoes (Sperry Songfish or Brown Leather Eastlands)


## WINTER

## BOYS K - 4th

- Green Long Sleeve Polo, Light Grey Pants, brown or black belt, grey or black socks, and ALL black sneakers.


## BOYS 5th - 8th

- Green Long Sleeve Polo, Dark Grey Pants, grey or black socks, and ALL black sneakers.


## GIRLS K - 4th

- Jumper with white long sleeve Peter Pan shirt, green socks or stockings, and approved shoes listed above.


## GIRLS 5th - 8th

- Long Sleeve Green Polo. Plaid Skort, green socks or stockings, and approved shoes listed above.


## GYM UNIFORM | BOYS \& GIRLS

## SPRING/FALL GRADES PK3-8th

Yellow OLGC t-shirt with green mesh shorts.
Any gym sneakers with plain white socks.

## WINTER GRADES PK3-8th

Green OLGC zippered sweatshirt and green sweatpants with the yellow OLGC t-shirt. Any gym sneakers with plain white socks.

## GROOMING \& PERSONAL APPEARANCE

- Attention to neatness and cleanliness in personal attire is an important aspect of a child's education.
- Shirts must be tucked in and shoes laced and tied at all times.
- Hair should be its natural color, clean, and neatly arranged.
- No extreme hairstyles for boys or girls will be permitted. Boys must maintain a well-groomed crewcut, neatly trimmed around the ears, short in the back and off the forehead at all times. The upright hair on the top of the head is cut relatively short (no longer /shorter than 2 inches, flattened).
- Boys/parents may be asked to get a haircut when, in the opinion of the school, it is needed.
- Striped colors, hair extensions, feathers/ beads/ accessories in the hair are not permitted.
- Hairbands, which match the school jumper, may only be worn by girls in K-4.
- Small headbands or simple ribbons may only be worn by girls in 5-8.
- As a general rule, students are not permitted to wear a hat of any kind at school except in any cold weather conditions or for medical reasons as determined by the school.
- Small post earrings only may be worn by girls (one pair at a time - no multiple piercings).
- Boys are not permitted to have pierced ears.
- Watches are permitted (no Fitbits, Apple/Smartwatches, etc.)
- A small crucifix or religious medal on a thin chain may be worn by boys and girls
- No other jewelry may be worn. Wristbands of any kind are not permitted.
- No make-up, nail polish, false nails/lashes, or colored lip-gloss may be worn.


## OTHER UNIFORM OPTIONS

- Additional school-approved uniform pieces are available and can be worn with the full uniforms listed above.
- These include sweaters, pullovers, button-down shirts, ties, and vests. They are not required but are permitted. Visit www.rissebrothers.com for details.


## CASUAL DRESS DOWN DAYS
